On this trip, we will have the opportunity to foster a relationships with people of Wanblee, South Dakota on the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation by ministering through children's programs and painting and weatherizing homes.

This can and will be a life-changing experience. Meeting new friends and developing relationships with children & their families will last in your hearts forever!

After two nights in Rapid City, South Dakota, we will work with trained, fun, and energetic YouthWorks counselors and meet and learn with teens from across the United States in Wanblee, South Dakota. The experience will include meaningful conversations, deep questions & intentional follow-up, taking you beyond cultural comfort zones and challenging understandings of justice, service & love, based in your relationship with Jesus Christ.

While on the Reservation, our "home away from home" will be the T.N.T. Rec Center in Wanblee. We will sleep on air mattresses and sleeping bags in boys' and girls' classrooms. All food is provided the week we are in Wanblee. While at the school, we will learn about the Native American Culture, build incredible relationships with the children and adults of Wanblee, and assist with programs guided by the YouthWorks counselors. Experiences might include hiking, daily devotionals, and painting homes, tutoring and playing with children!

We have 16 youth spaces with 4 adult guides available. Registrations will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis until filled. **A \$100.00 non-refundable deposit will secure your place in this incredible trip!**

Fundraising Possibilities

Butter Braid Sales

Start sales on November 1st – Turn in orders the first week of December

Deliver Orders around December 16th

(You receive approximately \$5 for every braid sold---so if you sell 20, you would receive \$100)

Hanson's Gift Cards

Ongoing throughout the year – Buy cards at 5% discount. Sell them for full price.

Example – If you buy or sell a \$100.00 gas card – you get \$5.00 put in your account.

Cinnamon Rolls

First Sunday of every month beginning in October. Need to be at church at 7:45am. This is a small fundraiser about \$40 each month.

Aluminum Can Collection Bin

Families who sign up to take care of bin on a month rotation will split the proceeds of the cans. (This is not easy work 😊--but you can earn \$100-\$250 in a month). Begin October 1
